Primary Responsibilities

- › The development of modification of architectural deliverables, artefacts and building blocks within the Technical or Application architectural disciplines based on background and experience;
- › The application of industry experience and knowledge to identify and recommend solutions, products and services to support our clients business and/or technology goals
- › Other related duties as requested.

Qualification

- › Working knowledge in defining and documenting baseline and target architecture views to meet business requirements, including and identification and estimation of relevant cost considerations throughout the transition periods).
- › Demonstrated ability to create and articulate technology or application views and link it back to business vision and values.
- › Area of expertise with relevant experience in either;
 - Technology Architecture: The creation of views for various technical building blocks including serves, storage, networks, operating systems, utilities and databases. This includes resolving impacts in the changes of one project or area to the entire technical landscape.
 - Application Architecture: The creation of views for various application building blocks including applications, information, data and integration. This includes resolving impacts in the changes of one project or area to the entire application landscape.
- › Experience in using a methodology to establish the objectives, principles, guidelines and standards of a specific architectural area. Certification and/or experience with The Open Group Architecture Framework (TOGAF) is desirable;
- › SAP experience is desirable
- › Demonstrated ability of solving business challenges with technology solutions;
- › Strong analysis and problem solving skills with the ability to consider vast amounts of information and be able to synthesize it into strategic and tactical direction;
- › Consulting experience and the ability to work on more than one task at a time;
- › Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with a demonstrated ability to work effectively in a team environment
